## **SYNOPSIS**

#### SHORT

During the negotiations for a new agreement for the metal industry in 1978, a group of libertarian militants defend their radical stance against their factory comrades while witnessing with disappointment the atomization of the workers' movement.

#### LONG

A group of libertarian militants spend a night in 1978 printing a leaflet. The agreement for the metal industry of the province of Gipuzkoa is about to be signed and they defend the need to continue the struggle. While writing and printing the leaflet, they reflect on personal relationships and speculate on communal living. The next day, in the entrance hall of the factory where they work, they join a workers' meeting and encourage their fellow workers to fight for better conditions. But the growing unionization of the workers' movement has taken away the influence they once had, moving their radical political project into irrelevance.

Irati Gorostidi Agirretxe (Egüés Valley, Navarre, 1988) is a filmmaker. She is currently developing her first feature film, *Anekumen*, which has been selected in Ikusmira Berriak 2022 and has participated in various markets and mentoring programs.

In 2022 she has finished the fiction short film *Contadores* and the documentary short film *San Simón 62* (codirected with Mirari Echávarri), which won X Films at Punto de Vista Festival in 2021 and premiered at the festival in 2022.

Her first work of fiction, the short film *Unicorn*, premiered in 2021 and is currently in distribution. She previously codirected *Euritan* with Arantza Santesteban, which was selected for the Kimuak 2017 short film catalogue and has been programmed in numerous festivals, including the Malaga Spanish Film Festival and Barcelona International Women's Film Festival.

In 2016 she directed her first film, *Pasaia Bitartean*, premiered at the Seville European Film Festival in the Resistencias section and programmed by the Anthology Film Archives in New York.

To develop the research that precedes the creation of *Contadores* and *Anekumen* she obtained a research residency at the Huarte Center for Contemporary Art, received an IKERTU research grant from the Basque Government and was selected for Tabakalera's NOKA mentoring programme.

She graduated in Fine Arts from the University of the Basque Country and studied a Master's degree in Contemporary Film and Audiovisual Studies at Pompeu Fabra University. In 2018 she received a Fulbright scholarship to study film at the New York Film Academy.
